## McKenzie Beach

Approximately 10 minute ride - 2km

## Tomakin Cove

Approximately 40 minute ride - 8km

With shallow reefs extending almost continuously the entire width of the cove, this South Coast gem is an excellent spot to sit back and relax. With little activity, this location is ideal for those seeking a relaxing time at the beach.

## Botanic Gardens

Approximately 45 minute ride - 9km

The Eurobodalla Regional Botanic Gardens all started with Mrs Pat Speirs. She saw the devastating effect developments were having on the region and made it her mission to help restore the lost vegetation. Be amazed by the ecological dance of regional flora and fauna. Admission is free.

## Observation Point Lookout

Approximately 50 minute ride - 10km

## Mogo Forest - Yowie Hunt

Approximately 100 minute ride - 20km

Approximately 60 minute ride - 13km
